

Tools Required: Drill, 5mm drill bit, screw driver, spirit level & pen/pencil

Time: 10 minutes

Difficulty: Easy peasy



1. Place your photoART panel on the wall where you would like it to be positioned. Use a spirit level to ensure it is straight. Now push the photoART panel firmly to the wall. The studs have small points on them which will mark your drill positions.

2. Mark the indentations made by the studs with a pen or pencil.

3. Drill holes with a 5mm drill at the marks.

4. Push the yellow wall plugs into the holes - the wall plugs have been supplied.

5. Screw the cups on to the wall by placing a screw (supplied) through the cup into the yellow wall plug with a screwdriver. Repeat this with the other cups.

6. The cups will now be in the correct position to align with the studs bonded to the back of your photoART panel. Carefully align and push the panel into place on your wall until you hear a click.

7. Your photoART panel is now installed in position.

Tools Required: Drill, 5mm drill bit, screw driver, spirit level & pen/pencil

Time: 10 minutes

Difficulty: Moderate



1. Place your photoART panel on the wall where you would like it to be positioned. Use a spirit level to ensure it is straight.

2. Mark the centre of the stud holes with a pen or pencil.

3. Drill holes with a 5mm drill at the marks.

4. Push the yellow wall plugs into the holes - the wall plugs have been supplied.

5. Screw the metal cups on to the wall by placing a screw (supplied) through the metal cup into the yellow wall plug with a screwdriver. Repeat this with the other cups.

6. The metal cups will now be in the correct position to align with the holes in your acrylicART photo panel. Screw the metal studs through the face of your acrylic panel into the metal cups behind. Repeat for all holes and studs.

7. Your photoART panel is now installed in position.
